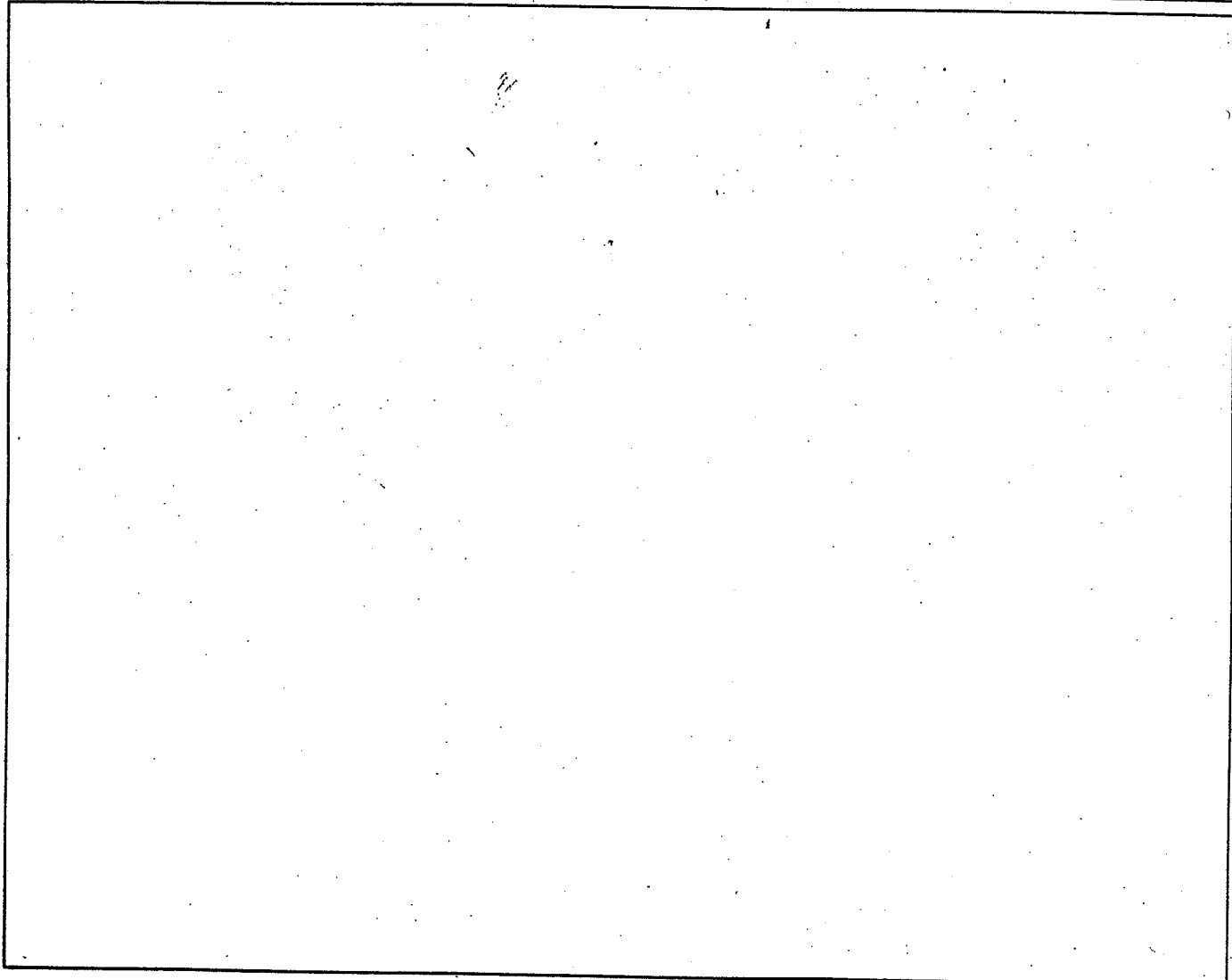

## GENERAL SITE PLAN REQUIREMENTS (Commercial, Institutional, and Industrial Buildings Included)

The zoning ordinance specifies minimum distances from the lot lines to your residence, building addition, and all other structures on the site. This includes but is not limited to such items as garages, storage sheds, porches, patios, and swimming pools. Information is also needed for fences as fences in the front yard are treated differently than fences in side or rear yards. The accuracy required for your measurements will depend on its relationship to the zoning requirements. Example: If the required minimum setback is five feet and you plan to build five feet from the property line you must be able to show us the property corners. We cannot accept a row of trees as your property line or the sidewalk or street or what you were told by someone who lives in your area. We want to avoid making you getting a survey of your property, but if we are in anyway unsure of where your property line is we will require a survey if you are building close to the required setback from your property line. If the same building is to be ten feet from the property line, the measurements do not have to be as accurate. We also need to know the sizes of all structure on the lot as you can only cover a portion of your lot.

This information is to be submitted in the form of a site plan containing the information requested below. This may be submitted on the last page if the application, on a separate sheet of 8-1/2x11 paper or on the plot plan made when the lot was surveyed. If it is a fencing application, use the back side of the application along with the fencing layout. A site plan is not a drawing of your proposed construction. It shows the location of your existing buildings and proposed addition with a single line drawing showing only the location of the exterior walls.

Site plans for commercial, industrial, and institutional buildings will vary with size, use, and relationship to other structures on the site. Basic requirements are location of streets or alleys bordering the new construction and location of any existing buildings within 30 feet of the proposed construction.

### SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

1. All site plans must be to scale and drawn with straight lines. Rough sketches will not be accepted.
2. Property lines must be proven by one of two means: ❶ the submission of a survey conducted by a surveyor licensed by the State of Illinois (the survey will be considered valid provided that no additions or deletions have been made to the property since the date of the survey); or ❷ the sighting by a City Inspector of true property line monuments place by a licensed surveyor.
3. The North direction must be shown on the site plan.
4. Locate your lot on the site plan and show its dimensions.
5. Show the streets and alleys bordering your lot.
6. Locate your main structure on the lot and show its dimensions and distances to property lines.
7. Locate any other structures on the lot and showing structure dimensions and distance to property lines and distance to the main structure.
8. Locate the proposed construction on the lot. Show its distance from the main structure and property lines.
9. Show your drainage plan for the new structure.
10. If the drawing is on a separate sheet of paper, make sure to include your name and address.
11. **BLUEPRINTS:** Blue prints are required. For residential structures these maybe plans provided by the builder or a firm that sells housing prints, provided that a specification sheet, to include a materials listing, is included and all utilities are located on the plans to include their distribution and capacities. For commercial, industrial and institutional plans they must be submitted under the approval of a State of Illinois licensed professional architect or a State of Illinois licensed professional engineer.

If you do not understand these requirements, contact the building inspector for help. If the information is not complete, the application will be returned delaying its approval.

### COST BASIS

1. Permit fees are based on the reasonable cost of the improvement. Estimated cost shall include all cost of labor and material given at fair market value. In absence of a bona fide contract establishing the estimated costs, the value of the construction shall be established by the code enforcement officer based on the area and type of construction.
2. If a portion of the contract is considered maintenance and a portion requires a permit, you must obtain a permit for the total amount.
3. Example: If you are installing new windows in your home and no structural changes are made, no permit is required. If you change the size of any windows requiring additional framing the permit must be for both the windows and framing.

## **1. Do I need a permit ?**

Per Section 105 of the International Building Code a permit is required when 'Any owner or authorized agent intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, repair, remove, convert, or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system...'

## **2. What requirements do I have to meet for the remodel of an existing structure ?**

Basically any portion of the structure that is to be remodeled must be brought into compliance with the current code. However per Section 3403 of the International Building Code any portion of the structure not to be remodeled does not have to be brought up to current code provided that the remaining structure is maintained and operated in a safe and sanitary condition.

With that said strict compliance with all codes may not have to be met per Section 3410 of the Code. Please contact the City Building Inspector early in your process to discuss your alternatives.

## **3. What is the fee for the permit ?**

The permit fee is based on the estimated cost of your construction. Please contact the City Building Clerk for a copy of the fee schedule (Included in Building Permit Packet).

## **4. What are the penalties for starting work without a permit ?**

Per City Code if any person initiates construction without first taking out a permit, such person shall pay, in addition to the regular fees prescribed for permits, a minimum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) or an amount equal to one hundred (100) percent of the fee required, whichever is greater, and shall be subject to all penalty provisions of the City Code.

## **5. Can the Building Inspector stop my project if I don't have a permit ?**

Yes. Per Section 114 of the International Building Code if the Building Inspector issues a stop work order you are required by law to stop working. If you continue to work you may be subject to fines or possibly arrest.

## **6. Should I contact the City prior to starting any construction project ?**

Yes. The City encourages open discussion regarding new construction projects and wants to work with you to ensure an easy and timely review and inspection process for your project.

## Commercial / Industrial

**Site Plans** – A set of engineering prints and calculations signed and sealed by a Professional Engineer licensed in the State of Illinois meeting the requirements of Article 15.46 “Stormwater Management” and Section 17 “Zoning” of the City Municipal Code, (whose requirements are summarized on the enclosed Preliminary Development Plan Checklist) must be submitted for all planned construction prior to the issuance of a stormwater management permit.

**Building Plans (Non Slab-On-Grade over 2,000 sq. ft., Major Renovations)** – A set of architectural prints and calculations signed and sealed by a Professional Architect or Professional Structural Engineer licensed in the State of Illinois meeting the requirements of the City’s Building Code must be submitted for all planned construction prior to the issuance of a building permit. These plans shall include but are not limited to:

1. A Structural Plan (Including truss diagrams and wall sections)
2. A Mechanical Plan
3. An Electrical Plan
4. A Plumbing Plan
5. An HVAC Plan

**Building Plans (Slab-On-Grade, Non Medical or Food Service, under 2,000 sq. ft., Minor Renovations)** – When a Commercial Slab-on-Grade Building or minor renovation defined as a renovation in which work totals less than 25% of the appraised valuation of the structure (not including medical or food service buildings) is proposed, the following items are required:

- A set of blue prints prepared by either the builder, a firm that sells housing prints, or the owner, provided that the prints are prepared in a professional manner meeting the following requirements:
  1. Wall dimensions, entrance locations, and window locations are shown
  2. Utility locations, sizes, and capacities are clearly shown
  3. Wall section and roof truss details are provided
  4. No sketch plans
- A specification sheet for the materials to be used

**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF PERMIT**

All work shall be performed as directed by the Director of Public Works. Work areas and excavations shall be maintained in a safe condition. This shall include erection of barricades, fencing, or any other protective devices required to safeguard the work area. The applicant assumes full and total liability for any and all accident claims, and damage to public property, arising from execution of the work authorized herewith.

**EXCAVATIONS AFFECTING PAVEMENT & PAVEMENT APPURTENANCES**

Limits of removal for pavement, curb and gutter, and PCC driveway and sidewalk, shall be saw-cut full depth. No. 5 dowel bars are required for PCC Pavement and curb and gutter replacement.

Flowable fill conforming to Illinois Department of Transportation specifications shall be used to backfill all excavations beneath, and within 3 feet of the outer edge of, pavement, curb and gutter, or high-grade shoulders (bituminous or concrete). The use of clean granular material for backfill may be permitted when seasonal constraints preclude the use of flowable fill.

Replacement materials (including type and thickness) for pavement curb and gutter, shoulders, sidewalks, and driveways, shall be as specified by the Director of Public Works. Unless otherwise approved, permanent pavement repairs must be performed with like materials. Repairing flexible pavements with rigid pavement (Portland cement concrete), and vice-versa, is not permissible in the absence of explicit approval by the Director of Public Works. Exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis and when certain materials are not available due to seasonal constraints.

**PERFORMANCE WARRANTY**

Restoration of public land and all affected appurtenances thereon, are subject to a 24-month performance warranty. This includes subsidence due to improper backfilling. Repair of documented failures that occur during the warranty period are the sole responsibility of the applicant, who by his or her signature affixed hereto acknowledges full understanding and acceptance of these provisions.
